Day 05 – GENERAL PUBLIC AWARENESS

On day 5 of the special camp, the NSS student volunteers addressed a group of people after gathering them at a particular place in their respective villages. The student volunteers addressed them about the basic health awareness and its related issues. The student volunteers explained and demonstrated the people about the importance of hand hygiene as well as the steps involved in proper handwashing. They also asked few people to repeat the steps of handwashing there by enabling them to learn the much-needed proper handwashing technique. The student volunteers also briefed them about the blood transfusion and its health benefits as well as its uses for others and cleared their doubts regarding some of the myths about blood transfusion. The students also described them about how to prevent waterborne diseases by simple techniques as well as explained them about the importance of proper waste disposal. They also told them about various health hazards and diseases that may arise due to stagnant water or improper disposal of waste. In this way the student volunteers created awareness amongst the general public by providing them with very useful information. Overall, it was an interactive session with villagers too actively participating and clarifying their doubts. The NSS student volunteers also pasted small flex banners with useful quotes and pictures about importance of education, corona prevention guide etc. The flex banners were pasted at public places like in bus stops, school walls, near ration shops.
