Report on Tree Plantation Conducted on 12th December 2020

6. Next phase solar installation.
7. Rain water harvesting system for hospital block.

Action Taken Report:

- To improve greenery in the campus, 21 saplings were planted behind the college building on 12.12.2020 which was sponsored by KV Star group. Everyday watering is done to these plants by gardener from 8.40 am -9.00 am.
- Weed removing tools 10 nos were purchased.
- Changing of bulbs to LED is completed in Hospital Dean office and MS office (30 bulbs) and in Annapoorna Lecture Hall (12 bulbs).
- Name boards and instruction boards written in local language are displayed in the walls of Biomedical Waste storage room.
- Requisition of extension of solar power panel and solar water heater for Hospital block is submitted and quotation is received from the distributors.
- Rainwater harvesting system was renovated.
