**ABSTRACT OF THE TALK**

- He discussed in brief about the following points :
  - Various causes of dermatological emergencies and how to manage acute skin failure.
  - Drugs used in dermatologic emergencies include steroids, IVIg, Immunosuppressives, Vincristine.
  - Steroids should not be used in staphylococcal scalded skin syndrome.
  - Usage of autoclaved banana leaves in cases of acute skin failure.
  - Usage of aluminium foil and green coated cloth to increase the temperature.
  - Usage of activated charcoal and baking soda to reduce the foul smell of the lesions.
- Questions on the topic were asked to the audience and the doctors who gave the right answer were awarded by the department & **Dr. C.R. Srinivas, MD.,** FRCP(Glasgow)., the guest speaker gave the prize.

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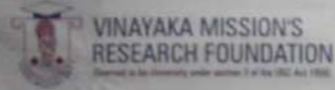
